# Providers must have a SC Part C Credential if they are:

- **t** Employed by a facility or agency that contracts to provide BabyNet early intervention services, *αnd*
- ♣ Seeing children who are eligible for BabyNet services, and
- ★ Named on the Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) as someone who will deliver BabyNet services.

- 90 Days to Complete
   "BabyNet Basic Training"
- Permanent Credential Issued


#### Current BabyNet Providers

- 120 Days to Complete "BabyNet Basic Training"
- Permanent Credential Issued

## **SC Part C Credential Facts**

- All providers working within the BabyNet system must hold a SC Part C Credential
- Credential is valid for 2 year period
- Training is required to maintain and renew the credential every 2 years
- \* Credential renewal requires 12 hours every 2 years
- All credential training credits are tracked in TECSBOOK 2.0 and transcripts are available ondemand
- The next renewal cycle will be in 2013
