Family Survey Talking Points

Family Training Visit prior to first 6-month IFSP or Exit

- 1. Since we will be conducting the semi-annual or 6-month IFSP in the coming weeks, we would like for families to complete a short survey to explain their experience with the early intervention program. We like to survey families two times during the duration of services. At the first 6-month IFSP and again at Exit.
- 2. Your responses to the survey are confidential. The answers will be analyzed as a group
- 3. The participant code on the postcard is used for tracking regional responses for comparison data. The password is used so that you will be linked directly to the survey and are able to login.
- 4. The information we receive from the surveys helps our State learn what is currently working and what improvements need to be made to the program. Family Outcomes data is reported to the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) annually. The surveys also provide the State with needs for training, practice changes and technical assistance that will help us better serve infants and toddlers.
- 5. Since you know your child best, we would love to receive feedback from you. There are two ways to complete the survey. You can click on the QR code and it will take you directly to the online survey. You will just need to enter your participant code and the password. If you lose the participant code and/or password, please contact your Service Coordinator. If you prefer, a paper survey will be mailed to you. You can complete it and mail it in using the self-addressed stamped envelope.
- 6. If assistance is needed, you may contact Family Connection of SC. They assist families and offer interpretive services for the completion of the Family Survey.
